The ReFrame Film Festival Returns: The 16th Season of ReFrame takes place on Jan 23-26. Emmanuel's Outreach Committee has chosen to sponsor Alanis Obomsawin's new film "**Jordan River Anderson; The Messenger**" about the battle for the right of Indigenous children to receive the same standard of social, health and educational services as the rest of the Canadian population.

Alanis Obomsawin's 52nd film tells the story of Jordan River Anderson, a young boy from the Norway House Cree Nation in Manitoba, whose lifelong hospitalization with a rare genetic disorder caused a political fight between the provincial and federal governments over the cost of his medical care, resulting in the establishment of the new Jordan's Principle around equity of access to health and social services for First Nations children. **The film will be screened at Showplace on Sat Jan 25th at 2:45pm.** An extended Q&A between Alanis Obomsawin and Drew Hayden Taylor will follow the screening. We have sponsored some of Alanis' other informative films in the past and anticipate this one will be equally excellent.
