Communion Prayer

L: From the midst of our tables, that are often cluttered with newspapers, shopping lists, bills, junk mail and other daily debris, we clear a space for bread and wine.

Beside souvenirs from places we've been, we are reminded of your mystery in creation, God. On our own, we often are unable to find the assurances you spoke of in our dusty forgotten Bibles on our bookshelves. Yet, we remember, as the followers of the past did, how you keep reaching out to us touching lives when they feel broken and in despair. Your living Word constantly comes to us and holds us in the midst of what we face, even now.

During these moments of isolation, we get a sense of what Jesus' disciples went through when their teacher and friend died.
