Residential School Exhibit at the Peterborough Museum: Until December 8th, the Peterborough Museum and Archives is hosting "We Were Taught Differently: The Indian Residential School Experience", an exhibit on loan from Lake of the Woods Museum in Kenora. This exhibition examines the Indian residential school experience, most particularly in the two schools that were in Kenora, Ontario - Cecilia Jeffrey and St. Mary's. It also includes mention of all six schools in [Treaty #3](#), as many local residents were sent to schools outside the immediate Kenora area.
